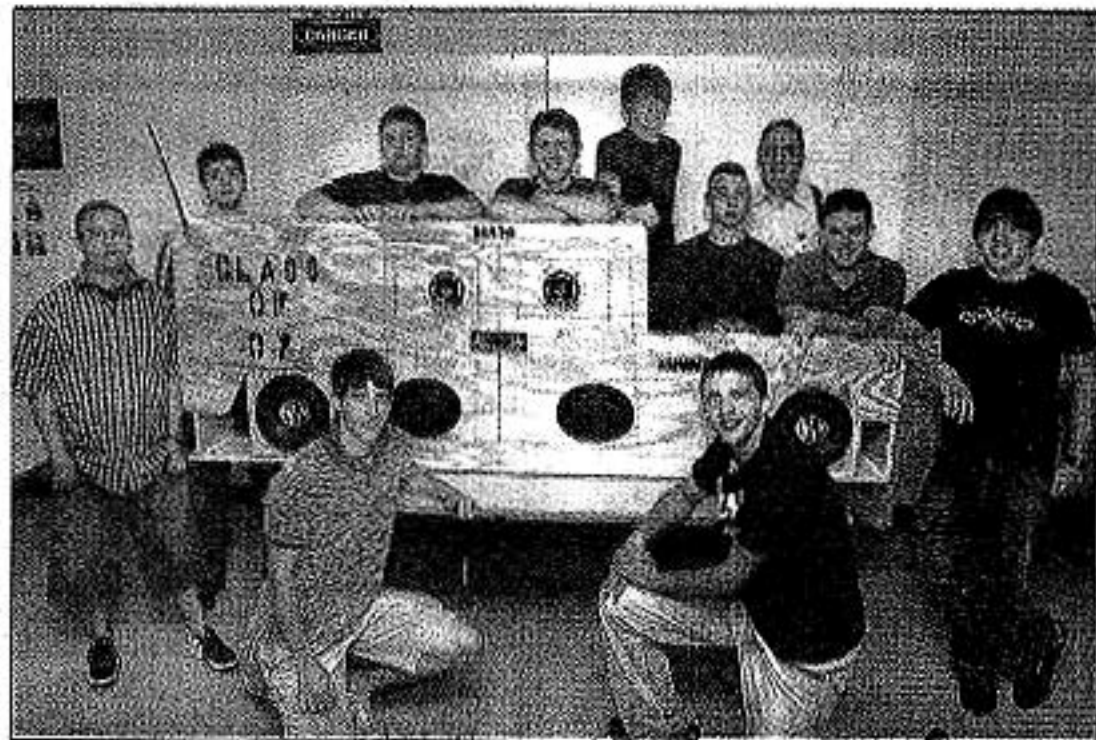


A flair for car audio installation
